GENERAL WAIVER, RELEASE, AND INDEMNIFICATION

In consideration for being permitted to utilize the facilities, services, and programs of the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd (“ECGS”) for any purpose, including but not limited to observation or use of facilities or equipment, or participation in any program affiliated with the ECGS, the undersigned, for himself or herself and any personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin, child, minor, or person over whom the undersigned has guardianship, hereby acknowledges, agrees and represents that he or she has, or immediately upon entering or participating will inspect and carefully consider such premises and facilities or the affiliated program. It is further warranted that such entry into the ECGS for observation or use of any facilities or equipment or participation in such affiliated program constitutes an acknowledgement that such premises and all facilities and equipment thereon and such affiliated programs have been inspected and carefully considered and that the undersigned finds and accepts same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of such observation, use, or participation.

IN FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF BEING PERMITTED TO ENTER THE ECGS FOR ANY PURPOSE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO OBSERVATION OR USE OF FACILITIES OR EQUIPMENT, OR PARTICIPATION IN ANY PROGRAM AFFILIATED WITH THE ECGS, THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the ECGS, its rector, vestry, directors, officers, employees, and agents (hereinafter referred to as “releasees”) from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of exposure to communicable diseases or injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise while the undersigned is in, upon, or about the premises or any facilities or equipment therein, or participating in any program affiliated with the ECGS.
2. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in, upon, or about the ECGS premises or in any way observing or using any facilities or equipment of the ECGS or participating in any program affiliated with the ECGS whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
3. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to negligence of releasees or otherwise while in, about, or upon the premises of the ECGS and/or while using the premises or any facilities or equipment thereon or participating in any program affiliated with the ECGS.
4. THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing RELEASE, WAIVER AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the state of Florida and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

The Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd ("ECGS") is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all members and guests. The ECGS reserves the right to deny access or membership to any person who fails to comply with safety protocols, policies and procedures that are in place to protect the health and well-being of all.

We expect everyone using the ECGS to act maturely, behave responsibly, and respect the rights/dignity of others.

- Carrying or concealing a weapon or any device or object that may be used as a weapon on ECGS property or at ECGS programs is not allowed.
- No lifeguards are available: Swim at your own risk.
- All non-swimmers are required to provide and wear a Coast Guard approved swim vest, or to remain in shallow water.
- Using or possessing alcohol or illegal substances on ECGS property is not allowed.
- No smoking: ECGS is a smoke-free environment.
- Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language, or any type of menacing behavior is not allowed.
- Physical contact with another person in an angry, aggressive, or threatening way is not allowed.
- Verbally abusive behavior, including angry or vulgar language, swearing, name-calling, or shouting is not allowed.
- Sexually explicit conversation or behavior; any sexual contact with another person is not allowed.
- Inappropriate, immodest, or sexually revealing attire is unacceptable.
- Theft or behavior that results in the destruction or loss of property is not allowed.
- Loitering within or on the grounds is not allowed.
- Showers are required before swimming is required.
- Walking (no running) only on the pool deck.
- Return equipment and chairs after use.
- Children should always be accompanied by a guardian.
- Check to assure all showers are turned off after use.
- The pool deck is a glass-free environment.
- Use of the pool is for members or business partners only.
- A waiver is required for single-day drop-in use.
- Infants and toddlers are required to use a diaper when swimming.
- Swimmers are asked to exit the water during hazardous weather.
- Swimmers are asked to avoid leaning or hanging on lane lines.
- Photography is not allowed on the pool deck.
- Avoid rough housing, fighting, and dunking in the pool.
- Flashing and strobe lights are not allowed on the pool deck.
- Respect all pool deck signage (wet surface, lane reservation, hazard, etc.).
- Help keep the pool deck clean by not littering.
- No comfort animals/pets (with the exception of a certified service animal).

The ECGS reserves the right to deny access or membership to any person who has been accused or convicted of any crime involving sexual abuse, is or has been a registered sex offender, has ever been convicted of any offense relating to the use, sale, possession, or transportation of narcotics or habit forming and/or dangerous drugs, or is presently or habitually under the of dangerous drugs or chemicals, narcotics or intoxicating beverages.
